A Typical Testing Time Line for Students

Freshmen Year

ERB: Education Records Bureau: Students complete a writing sample--test scores and results are discussed in English class.

Possible Biology SAT II: For high achieving freshmen in Biology. Please check with teacher about preparation for the test. May or June test date. Register online @ www.collegeboard.com, mail or phone.

Sophomore Year

PSAT: Taken in October (optional). Register in the Student Center.

CAPT Test: Connecticut Academic Performance Test is given in May. Administered to all sophomores it includes: Math, Language Arts, Science and Interdisciplinary Assessment.

Possible SAT Subject Test(s): Taken upon completing a course and to use (possibly) as SAT Subject Test for college submission. Register online @ www.collegeboard.com, mail or phone.

Junior Year

PSAT: (practice, National Merit) Taken in October. Register in the Student Center one week prior to test date. Cash only.

SAT Reasoning Test: Taken in March, May or June. Register online @ www.collegeboard.com, mail or phone.

Other SAT Subject Tests(s): May or June. Register online @ www.act.org, mail or phone.

ACT: April or June test date. Register online @ www.act.org, mail or phone.

Advanced Placement Tests: May

Senior Year

SAT Reasoning Test: October or November test date. Register online @ www.collegeboard.com, mail or phone.

SAT Subject Test(s): If not completed in junior year.

ACT: October or December test date and if not taken in junior year. This test is required for some Colleges in the Midwest, West or South. Register online @ www.act.org, mail or phone.

Advanced Placement Tests: May
